POINT SYSTEM

WIN	10 points	SCORE	¼ point
TIE	5 points	DEFAULT WIN	16 points
LOSS	0 points	DEFAULT LOSS	0 points
EACH END	1 point	MAX. ROCKS FOR SCORE	12 rocks/3points
BLANK END	½ point	BYES	16 points

SCORE CARDS

It is the responsibility of the vice/skip to submit completed scorecards after game completion. If a score card is not submitted by the last night of the draw, both teams will get 0 points for the game in question. Rescheduled games MUST be played prior to the end of the draw. If teams are tied at the end of the draw, the total number of wins will break the tie. If still tied by the total games won, then the number of ends won, will break the tie. If still tied, then the winner will be determined by the number of rocks scored.

TIME LIMIT

ALL curlers MUST be off the ice by 9pm and 11:10 sharp. Any member may file a complaint – in writing – to the mixed committee against a team that does not follow this rule, provided that the member has noted the score from the last completed end before the time limit expires, as the final score may need to be adjusted.

GENERAL

Free Guard Zone: (4 rocks) rule will apply. Either team can remove their OWN stones from the Free Guard Zone at any time.

Back Line Rule: The back line is intersecting with the circles, which allow for a measure in the middle of an end to see if a rock is in play.

Hog Line Violation: The front of the rock MUST be delivered prior to it reaching the hog line....see OCA rules for details.

If a losing team concedes the game after the 6th end, the team that is winning scores 1 point and 1 rock for each unplayed end.

Curling Etiquette:

Most important rule: Have Fun ☺ ☺

Second most important rule: The winning team buys the losing team a drink and the losing team reciprocates.

Leads & Seconds should be standing at the hog line, not the back of the house.

Leads & Seconds should not be in the house when rocks are being measured.
